Also, the financial backing from alumni helps to slow the annual growth rate of tuition and to fund financial aid programs. Penn Law School gives out over \$8 million in financial aid to its students per year; however, more than that is needed to fulfill the financial aid obligations to students. Penn Law attracts some of the brightest minds in the world, yet approximately 80% need support to attend the law school. Without financial aid it would be nearly impossible to maintain the level of academic excellence that makes Penn Law such a dynamic institution.
