Before starting as Program Director with CERL, Andrew was a Mellon Postdoctoral Teaching Fellow in the Department of Philosophy at the University of Pennsylvania. Prior to that, he spent a year as a Visiting Assistant Professor of Philosophy at Illinois Wesleyan University, a small liberal arts college. In 2012, he completed his Ph.D. in Philosophy at Indiana University, where he was the recipient of the James B. Nelson Dissertation Year Fellowship, the Louise B. McNutt Dissertation Research Fellowship, and the Philosophy Department's Outstanding Associate Instructor Award. Andrew's research and teaching has focused on a number of issues in moral philosophy, philosophy of action, applied ethics, and social and political philosophy. He has published peer-reviewed articles in *Pacific Philosophical Quarterly*, *Ethical Theory and Moral Practice*, and elsewhere.
