MINUTES OF MEETING OF COUNCIL OF CORPORATION LAW SECTION OF DELAWARE STATE BAR ASSOCIATION

OCTOBER 16, 1985

 \supset

A meeting of the Council of the Corporation Law Section was held on October 16, 1985 at 4:00 P.M. in the offices of Morris, Nichols, Arsht & Tunnell. Council members present were: A. Gilchrist Sparks, III, John H. Small, Lewis S. Black, Donald A. Bussard, Stephen P. Lamb, R. Franklin Balotti, Edward M. McNally, and David B. Brown.

The minutes of the September 18, 1985 meeting were approved as submitted.

The review of 1986 legislative proposals focused principally upon the memorandum dated October 15, 1985, which Mr. Sparks had circulated to Council members prior to the meeting.

- With respect to Section 145 and the recent crisis in D & O insurance coverage, it was agreed that a committee should be established, co-chaired by John Small and Don Bussard, to study and report back to the Council as to what legislation, if any, should be proposed on the subject. Mr. Sparks requested that the Co-Chairmen in consultation with the Secretary appoint at least two other Section members to this Committee. Mr. Black pointed out that the rise in D & O claims, which had recently increased by 270%, posed a serious problem. Mr. Lamb suggested that the Committee study the proposal Professor Loss had made at one time to place limits on director liability. Mr. Balotti

added his recollection of a study which purported to show that placing limits on director liability resulted in more judgments being rendered against directors. There was discussion of the fact that Virginia had recently made changes in its statute on director liability which appeared to make it more attractive than the Delaware statute. It was noted that the appointment of a Section 145 committee would signal the corporate community that we are concerned about the problem.

- With respect to liquidation and dissolution, it was agreed that a committee should be formed, to be chaired by Steve Lamb, for the purpose of considering an overhaul of Subchapter X of the DGCL. Mr. Sparks asked that Mr. Lamb, in consultation with the Secretary, appoint other Section members to this committee. There was general agreement that the current provisions on liquidation and dissolution are very confusing and merit attention. Noting that revising these provisions will be a big job, Mr. Sparks added that there should be no mandate for Mr. Lamb's committee to come up with a legislative proposal for the current fiscal year. Mr. Black suggested that the Liquidation and Dissolution Committee study the corresponding Model Act provisions.
- With respect to possible amendments to other DGCL provisions, it was agreed that none warranted appointment of a special committee but could instead be handled by the Drafting Committee. These provisions include Section 338 (domestication), Section 389 (temporary transfer of domicile), Section 216 (required vote as to directors), Sections 251 and 252 (mergers),

and Sections 243 and 244 (retirement of stock and reduction of capital). With respect to Section 141(e), there was discussion of whether there was any need specifically to name lawyers among those on whose professional advice directors may rely. Mr. Balotti indicated that a Delaware Supreme Court decision makes it clear that directors may rely on lawyers and that such an amendment may not be necessary in light of that decision.

With respect to the Section's CLE activities, Mr. Sparks reported that he had spoken with David Erisman who expressed appreciation for our interest in putting on a CLE program but said that the CLE schedule was fully booked for the coming year. Mr. Sparks suggested that the Council address this matter again next spring and perhaps plan a CLE program for the 1986/87 fiscal year.

Regarding the "Model Act Project" it was agreed that it might be useful to study the new Model Act but that our official objective should simply be to review the entire DGCL. Mr. Sparks stated that we should not be proposing a complete overhaul of the DGCL at this time. Mr. Black noted that we may have differences with the Model Act drafters in terms of policy choices but that the Model Act contains some good technical provisions which merit our study. Mr. Balotti stated that we should avoid giving the appearance that Delaware will look to the Model Act in deciding what revisions to the DGCL are or are not needed. It was suggested that while this view has constituted our traditional position, the Council may wish to reassess that position.

Mr. Goldman was absent and unable to report on the subject of public disclosure of unserved complaints in Chancery Court. In Mr. Goldman's absence, the Secretary reported that he had discussed the subject with Bar President Crompton who does not neccessarily support the existing Chancery Court rule but thinks it was based historically on the following considerations (comments from the Council membership are reflected in parentheses):

- (a) to prevent defendants in sequestration suits from learning of the suit and taking action before they were served (a consideration now moot for the most part);
- (b) a perceived reluctance of plaintiffs to permit other plaintiffs to learn about a complaint before it is served (a reluctance not voiced by Joe Rosenthal or Bill Prickett); and
- (c) a sense that defendants are entitled to learn of lawsuits against them through service rather than through newspaper reports (a sense not shared by the Federal Court which does not restrict access to complaints prior to service).

There was general agreement that, to the extent any of these considerations had continuing vitality, they are outweighed by the benefits of permitting attorneys to have access to Chancery Court complaints once they have been filed.

Mr. Balotti circulated a draft letter to Chancellor Allen from the Section under Mr. Sparks' signature endorsing Mr. Balotti's proposal to Chancellor Allen that the Court consider opening newly filed complaints to the public. It was agreed that this

letter should be sent with certain modifications as deemed appropriate by Mr. Sparks.

After a brief discussion, it was agreed that the questionnaire to Section members drafted by Mr. McNally should be finalized with several minor changes and circulated by the Secretary to all Section members.

It was agreed that Mr. Sparks' report to the DSBA Executive Committee should include the following items:

- 1. A questionnaire is being sent to all Section members;
- 2. The Section will be reviewing the DGCL to determine whether any legislative changes should be proposed by the Section;
- 3. Several committees have been formed to address specific areas of the DGCL; and
- 4. The Council, in consultation with David Erisman, has determined that the Section will not sponsor a CLE program during this fiscal year but will consider such a program for use in the 1986-87 fiscal year.

There being no new business, the meeting was adjourned at approximately 4:55 P.M.


