

- The Certificate in Law requires the successful completion of four Penn Law courses: LAWM 511 U.S. Law and Legal Methods (Required) and three additional Penn Law elective courses. Elective courses may be from either the Master in Law curriculum or upper level JD curriculum.
- Students must be members of the University of Pennsylvania community to earn a Certificate in Law.
- Students must complete the courses required for the Certificate during the candidate's primary course of study.
- Students must achieve a grade of B- or better in all courses counting toward the Certificate.
- The Certificate in Law will be granted by the University of Pennsylvania Law School faculty to students who successfully complete its requirements.
